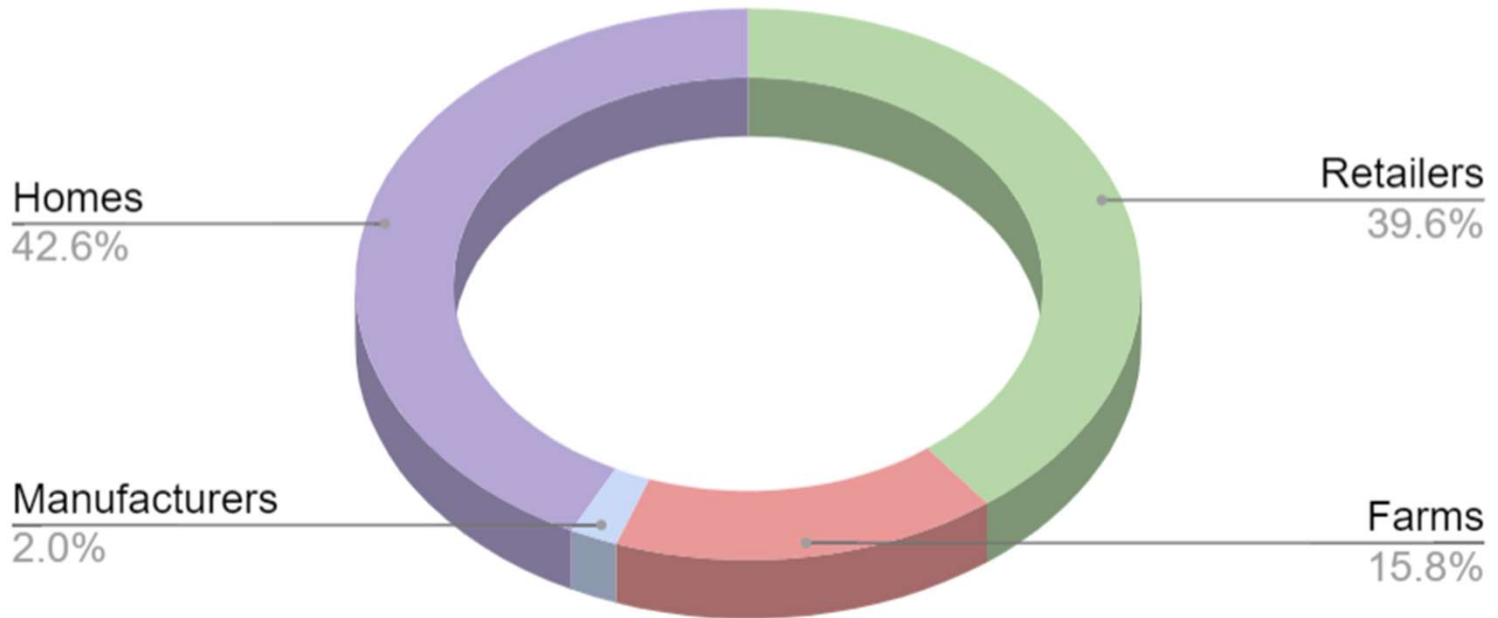

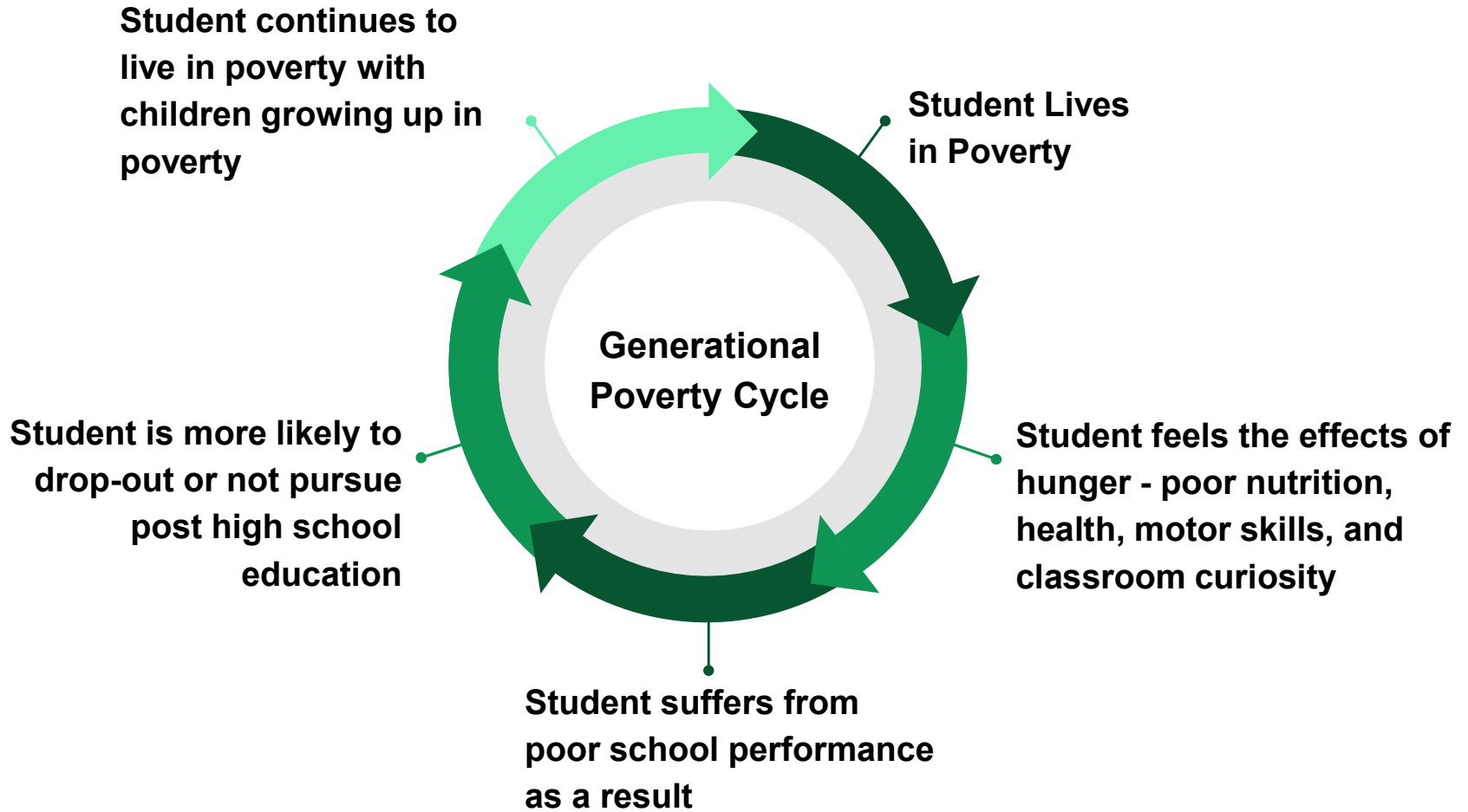


Spread of Food Waste



Affordability and Accessibility:

- Food Stamps/ SNAP Benefits affects affordability
 - Unbalanced system for paid aid
 - Affordability affects Accessibility due to store prices
 - Store sell less nutritional food

Fighting Hunger at the School Level

- Educational support through school programs
- Nutritional support with meal programs
- Mandate financial and food education



Fixing Unbalanced Federal Aid:

- 30% living in cheapest areas have SNAP reduced by \$10-\$20
 - 30% living in the most expensive areas have SNAP increased by \$10-\$20
 - Leaves 40% unaffected by SNAP correction
